This scholarship is offered to a student pursuing a degree in life or environmental sciences. The recipient may apply for renewal of \$1,000 for his/her senior year upon successful completion of the junior year. The applicant must be a graduate from a high school in either Calaveras or Tuolumne County and will have completed two years of undergraduate college work with a minimum of a 2.5 GPA.
